


November 2019 Plus, the Veteran's Day Event at Bassett Place

Carlos Delgado brought a 1/48th scale F-101B Voodoo and a 1/35th scale Sdkfz 251 from Tamiya.

Justiin Segovia had two 1/700th scale ships to show. One was a U-boat, the other was a Z-class Destroyer. I believe that makes both German.




