## CLUB NEWS

The Third meeting of the year has come and gone. More than 30 members, family and guest were in attendance at the meeting which was a nice turn out of the memberships with a good number of models bought to show.

**Rodney Rogers** was back after some months working out of the area. He brought some nice models to show and more about them later.

**Jim McDaniel**, our Austin area member reported that he had some success at San Antonio during the **ScaleFiesta**. Jim reports that there were about 600 models entered. Jim said that he was lucky to win the following: 2nd in the 1/48 single engine prop in-line other than US with an Airfix Seafire F.XVII, 2nd in the 1/48 single engine prop radial other than US with the Tamiya Zero A6M5, 2nd in the 1/48 single engine jet with Eduard Mig 21

SMT, and 3rd in the 1/48 multi engine prop with Tamiya Do 335-A12. Editor's note: There must have been some really great models there if Jim was only able to win 2nds and 3rds. Jim wore his El Paso Scale Model Society cap to the event to show his loyalty to our club.

**Mike Boudreaux** sent out some pictures of him in the nose of "FIFI", the B-29 that was in town over the weekend. Lucky guy.

## THE MEETING

**John Estes** gave some modeling tips in a seminar that lasted at least 1 and one half hours. Several comments from those that watched were positive. John covered glues and how to apply them, seam filling with putty and sprue. He stretched some sprue, made some seat belts, and made one seat from a vac u form blank that he had made. He

filled some seams on a first build by a new modeler showing a couple of ways that the seams could be filled. He then did some rigging on a 1/72nd scale P-26 using .008 wire. He had a 30mm figure on a wooden dowel to show one method to use to paint figures. He made wing tip lights for an FW 190 from clear sprue and some rivets and a

couple of exhaust shrouds for an A-20G or B-25 that used individual exhaust stacks.

**Mike Boudreaux** showed how to add buckles to the seat belts and tried out some of the homemade tools and a scribe that John brought to use during his presentation.

**Mike King** had several finished items to show this month. He brought an Italeri Jaguar Gr-1 and an Airfix Buccaneer, both in British markings and in the over all sand scheme from Desert Storm One era. He also had an Italeri Su-27 in Ukrainian markings and with the splinter camouflage. His last model was a Revell F-18E Super Hornet in CAG markings from the Kestrels ca. 2009. these decals were from the DMX line. All models were in 1/72nd scale. Mike has become our most prolific aircraft modeler.

**Wayne Williamson** has been working on his shelf of doom or cleaning up his partial builds. He brought seven 1/35th scale armor models to show. The first listed was the Neubaufahrzeuge Nb.Fz PzKpfw V as used in the Norwegian campaign early in WWII. Another was the Academy MIFV in IFOR markings. He had a Tamiya Pz IVD built from the very old kit in North African campaign markings. He had a Cromwell in Normandy markings and a model of the Tiger I prototype.

Wayne also had a Trumpeter Centauro and the last was an Academy M2 Bradley as used in the invasion of Iraq in Desert Storm. Some interesting and unusual kits that some of us had never seen except in the box.


